R.A.C.

We have a new club to assist students that are having difficulty recognizing their responsibility(ies) at school. It is called **Responsibility Awareness Club or RAC** for short. This is a new club that reminds students of their responsibilities at Cayuse Prairie. The expectations are that all students will:

- **Be Safe**
- **Be Respectful**
- **Be Responsible**
- **Be a Learner**

We are mostly focusing on middle school students at this time, but will expand to K-4 as space allows. We want all students to be successful and this is another way to support them in doing their personal best at school.

Handbook Procedure Changes:

- 1) **Regarding Tardies:** Students with 5-10 tardies in a semester will make up lost time during the student's lunch/recess. 11+ tardies in a semester will result in the student making up loss time after school from 3:30pm-4:00pm.

- 2) **Regarding Discipline Referrals:** Students who receive two Level 2 referrals in a school year will automatically receive a Level 3 referral. A Level 3 discipline referral could result in suspension or school expulsion. See student handbook for full menu of consequences.
